Summary

While visiting Chiefswood National Historic Site students explore the roles and responsibilities of Pauline Johnson and her family. Students will compare their own roles and responsibilities within their lives at school and home to the lives of the Johnson family. Students will then get the opportunity to make a wampum belt bracelet to represent their roles and responsibilities within their lives at school and home.

Description

The program will be 1.5-2 hours in length. Please allow your group additional time to browse and ask additional questions.

- Introduction and Museum etiquette
- Tour of Chiefswood National Historic Site that focuses on roles and responsibilities of the Johnson Family.
- Recap of Johnson Family roles and responsibilities
- Discussion on the differences and similarities of their own roles and responsibilities compared with the Johnson Family's
- Wampum Belt Bracelet craft
